

## **ADMISSION POLICY**

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Clients are accepted for treatment in the home on the basis of reasonable criteria and under the expectation that the clients medical, nursing, and social needs can be met adequately by the Agency in the client's place or residence.

The organization shall make available and provide services to all persons without regard to race, color, creed, sex, national origin, handicap, sexual orientation, age, marital status, status with regard to public assistance or veteran status, in compliance with 45 CFR Parts 80, 84, and 91, respectively. All services are available without distinction to all program participants, regardless of diagnosis. Agency shall not deny admission to people with a contagious disease, including, but not limited to, HIV, MRSA, and Hepatitis. All persons and organizations that either refer persons for services or recommend the agency's services shall also be advised of same.
